The dose window on the top of the Diskus® tells how many doses are left in the Diskus®.



The numbers will turn red when there are only five doses of medicine left in the Diskus®. This will alert you to get a refill of your medication. When the number reads zero, all the medicine is gone. Throw the Diskus® away.
